Generation Next is a not-for-profit organisation that provides education and information about the prevention and management of mental illness in youth to professionals, young people and the wider community. Our objective is to raise community awareness of mental illness through increasing mental health literacy, reducing associated stigma and positively influencing individual and community behaviour to improve the mental health of young people.

Sydney Mental Health and Wellbeing of Young People Seminar will be held on **Friday, 4th August at Sydney Town Hall** and is ideally suited for frontline professionals in the education, community and health sectors that work directly with young people as well as parents.

The program this year features topical issues such as:

- Preventing depression
- Managing anxiety
- Mental health first aid
