### PROCUREMENT OF EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES

**Does your P&C Association know** what the limitations are when a P&C Association raises funds for a school project (e.g. a sunshade or air conditioning) and purchases it through the school?

- **What is the value of the purchase if all funds, excluding GST, are donated from the P&C?**  
*The Department of Education has procurement policies in place including the methods to procure and delegate limits based on value and position. The Department also has contracted suppliers of goods and services which are required to be used for particular items. Funds donated by the P&C are exclusive of GST. The department pays the GST value and then subsequently claims the input tax credit. All items donated to a school by a P&C become the property of the department.*
- **Who is responsible for GST?**  
*The Department of Education (school) is responsible for the GST amount.*
- **Who is responsible for insurance?**  
*The school is responsible for managing insurance as it is now an **asset** of the Department of Education.*
- **Who is responsible for replacement / operational cost / repair / maintenance of donated assets?**  
*It is the school's responsibility for all operational costs, including any warranty.*
