## LODGEMENT OF NOMINATIONS AND CANDIDATE PROFILE FORMS

Completed Nomination Forms and Candidate Profile Forms must be received by the Returning Officer, NSW Electoral Commission from Thursday 9 March 2023 and by no later than **12.00 noon**, **Friday 28 April 2023**. A candidate may only withdraw his/her nomination in writing so as to be received by the Returning Officer prior to the close of nominations at 12.00 noon, Friday 28 April 2023. Any defect in a nomination form or a candidate profile must be rectified by the candidate prior to the close of nominations.

Completed Nomination forms and Candidate Profile forms can only be lodged by one the following methods:

## PRESIDENT CONTACT DETAILS

To be eligible to vote your P&C Association was requested, via email issued on Monday 6 February 2023 to submit the contact details of the President (or the Secretary or another member nominated by the Association if the President will be a candidate in the election) of your P&C Association to the Federation of Parents and Citizens Associations of NSW. To be eligible, the name of the President (or the Secretary or another member nominated by the Association if the President will be a candidate in the election) must be submitted so that it is received by the Federation of Parents and Citizens Associations of NSW by no later than 12.00 noon, Wednesday 8 March 2023. The President (or the Secretary or another member nominated by the Association if the President will be a candidate in the election) of your P&C Association will be responsible for submitting your P&C Association's vote.

## **VOTING**

If a ballot is necessary, voting material will be posted to all eligible P&C Associations on **Friday 5 May 2023**. The ballot will close at 12.00 noon, Friday 7 July 2023 and the count will be conducted at **1.30pm, Friday 7 July 2023** at the NSW Electoral Commission. The method of voting for this election is 'First Past the Post' using numbers.
