



Successful CBP22 P&C projects by project scope	Number	Percentage
Playground upgrade e.g. playground equipment, soft fall etc	35	19%
COLA installation or upgrade to outdoor learning space	27	15%
Accessibility improvement e.g. toilet upgrade, entrance, pathway access, sensory play space etc	26	14%
Sports court resurfacing, sport field or equipment upgrade	26	14%
School hall, library or classroom upgrade e.g. AV equipment, extension, accessibility lighting, ventilation	16	9%
Yarning Circle, landscaping, drainage, irrigation, fencing	13	7%
Shade, awning, pergola	10	5%
Others	10	5%
Canteen or kitchen upgrade	9	5%
Water refill stations	7	4%
Signage , notice board etc	4	2%
Equipment purchase	2	1%
Grand Total	185	100%





Reporting – Points system



Points required

\$30,000 and under	0 points	
\$30,001 - \$60,000	50 points	from Category B <i>OR</i> C
\$60,001 - \$100,000	90 points	from Category B AND C
100,001 or more	130 points	from Category B <i>AND</i> C



Reporting - Evidence

Required for any amount

Category B

50 points	Certificate of occupancy
50 points	Local council letter of completion
50 points	Before and after photos
50 points	Licensed tradesperson's letter of completion
40 points	Published media coverage

Category C

50 points	Invoices & proof of payment
40 points	Transaction ledger
50 points	Statutory Declaration





